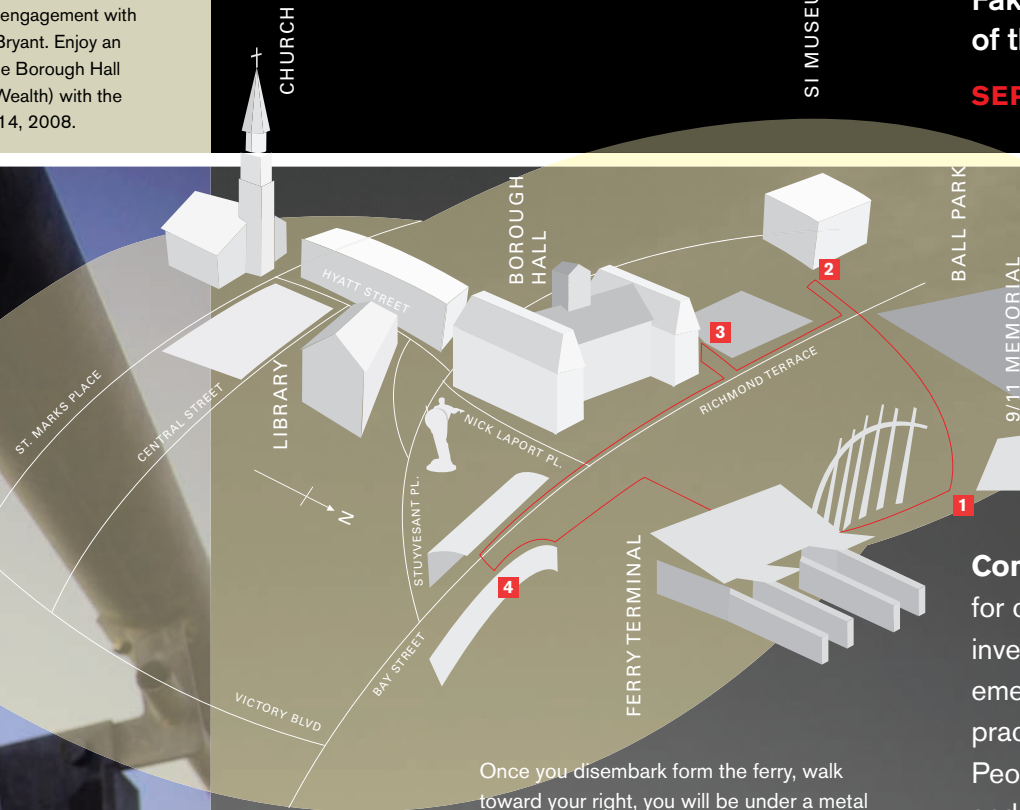

HOP ON THE FREE FERRY AND EXPLORE STATEN ISLAND

Conflux is the annual New York festival for contemporary *psychogeography*, the investigation of everyday urban life through emerging artistic, technological and social practice exploring the urban environment. People from a wide variety of backgrounds and cultures come together at the festival to re-imagine the city as a playground, a space for positive change and an opportunity for civic engagement.

Fake Attraction is based on the concept of *dérive* and is meant to attract tourists riding the Staten Island ferry. Four Fake Attraction sites have been set up to pique the interest and curiosity of ferry passengers enough to entice them to disembark and leave the ferry terminal area to explore St. George, Staten Island, rather than return to Manhattan immediately.

Once you disembark from the ferry, walk toward your right, you will be under a metal canopy, follow the map below to discover all the Fake Attractions.

LOCK OF LOVE
